



June 7, 2021—The Warren Township School District has information available for citizens interested in running for the board of education.

The Warren Township Board of Education will have three vacancies in the November 2, 2021, annual School Election, Shannon Regan, a spokesperson for the district, announced today. A full-term on the school board runs for three years. The district will have three full-term seats available.

A candidate must file a nominating petition with the county clerk for his or her name to appear on the ballot during the November Annual School Election. The deadline to submit the nominating petition is 4:00 p.m. Monday, July 26, 2021. The election is scheduled for Tuesday, November 2, 2021.

The School Board Candidate Kit includes information about nominating petitions, legal qualifications for school board candidacy, and the role of the school board member. Information about the New Jersey School Ethics Act and important dates in the school election process are also included.

“One of the most meaningful contributions that citizens can make to their community is serving on the local board of education,” said Michael McClure, NJSBA president. “I encourage all interested citizens to consider school board membership. It doesn't require a degree in education, or a background in politics. However, it does require a sincere interest in the community, its children, and their education.”
